Founded in 1956, the Management Development Institute of Singapore (MDIS) is one of Singapore's oldest not-for-profit professional institutes for lifelong learning. MDIS has two main subsidiaries: Management Development Institute of Singapore Pte Ltd which oversees its Singapore academic operations, and MDIS International Pte Ltd which focuses on MDIS' globalisation strategy.

MDIS offers internationally-accredited courses in Business and Management, Engineering, Fashion and Design, Health and Nursing, Health Sciences, Technology, Languages and Education, Life Sciences, Media and Communications, Psychology, Tourism and Hospitality Management and Safety and Environmental Management. These programmes are offered in collaboration with renowned universities in the United Kingdom and the United States of America. AWARDS AND CERTIFICATIONS

MDIS is EduTrust certified, attesting to its commitment to exemplary education and business excellence standards. The institute was first awarded the certification in 2010 – subsequently renewed it for four years in 2014, 2018 and 2023. MDIS was also one of the first Private Education Institutions (PEIs) to be registered under the Enhanced Registration Framework.

The institute achieved a double win at the Singapore Prestige Brand Award (SPBA); it was one of four winners as well as the overall winner of the SPBA - Heritage Brands 2018. In 2017, MDIS was ranked 4th in the Enterprise 50 Awards for its contributions in spurring Singapore's economy. Continuing with its long-standing tradition of giving back to society, the MDIS Education Trust Fund (inaugurated in 1999) supports deserving students facing financial difficulties in pursuing their education in Singapore. To date, MDIS has awarded more than 8,000 scholarships and bursaries totalling S\$6.3 million. Equally vested in corporate-level training, MDIS' corporate training arm, the Management Development and Consultancy, was set up in 1995 to cater to the training needs of the workforce. In 2014, MDIS acquired the Service Quality Centre to diversify its offerings in training solutions across the region.

Apart from the main Singapore campus, MDIS has international campuses in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, Johor, Malaysia, and Dushanbe, Tajikistan. MDIS also has representative offices in India and Indonesia, as well as agents throughout Southeast Asia.

SHORT COURSES IMMERSION PROGRAMMES AND WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS



Young Learners' Immersion ESL Programme

Immersion ESL programme is specially designed for young learners aiming to enhance their English language skills, boost confidence and improve communication abilities. Attendees will comprehensively understand the techniques and artistic principles behind creating stunning latte art. They will leave with the confidence and skills necessary to transform a simple cup of coffee into a visual masterpiece, making them well-equipped to pursue latte art as a hobby or potentially as a professional barista.



How to Craft a Gift (Workshop)

Upon completing this course, learners will be proficient in creating realistic fabric roses through hands-on experience, demonstrating good craftsmanship in their work. Learners can assemble the crafted roses into aesthetically pleasing arrangements, showcasing their creativity and attention to detail. Learners can tailor their DIY rose gifts to suit various occasions and personal preferences, adding a personalised touch to their creations.

Through this experience, learners will gain confidence in their creative abilities and feel empowered to craft heartfelt gifts for friends and family on special occasions.

Learners will hone their problem-solving skills related to crafting and how they can creatively solve common issues that may arise during the gift-making process. Overall, this DIY rose gift-making session will equip participants with practical skills to create meaningful, customised gifts for their loved ones.



Designing a Fashion Collection (Workshop)

This course aims to familiarise participants with the fashion design process. With instructions on mind-mapping and brainstorming, the course emphasises one's critical thinking abilities, with instructions on mind-mapping and brainstorming techniques. 3D Fashion Design Software (Workshop)

By the end of the "Fundamentals of 3D Fashion Using Browzwear" course, participants will comprehensively understand 3D fashion design and visualisation using Browzwear software. Throughout the course, participants will master Browzwear Software, develop proficiency in operating Browzwear and gain familiarity with its interface, tools, and features, including:

Digital Garment Creation: Learn the essential techniques for creating 3D digital garments, including pattern making, fabric selection, and virtual sewing.

Fit and Visualisation: Learn how to achieve accurate virtual garment fit, drape and movement, allowing for realistic simulations and visualisations.

This course aims to equip participants with the knowledge and practical skills needed to excel in 3D fashion design using Browzwear, making them valuable assets in the fashion and apparel industry.



Fashion 101 for Acing a Job Interview (Workshop)

- Introducing the fundamentals of AI in research and study;
- Demonstrate key AI tools that assist in data collection, analysis and content generation;
- Explore practical applications of AI for personalised study strategies.



3D Printing: From Idea to Reality (Workshop)

We generate ideas every day. Through 3D printing technology, we can facilitate the realisation of our ideas without going through the tedious process of achieving them as an end product. This hands-on interactive workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to understand how to generate, design and produce their products.

Students will explore and understand the technology, concepts and processes of 3D Printing from idea to printed end product. Upon completion, participants will be able to understand and differentiate different types of 3D printing technologies and bring home their 3D printed designs.



Lego Robotics & Coding (Workshop)

Encourage hands-on motor skills through robot construction:

- 1. Practice eyes and hand coordination
- 2. Elevate observance during part searching

Develop Socio-emotional skills through working with partners

- Instil logical thinking through robot and coding
- Impart Problem Solving skills through correcting own mistakes during robots construction & coding
- Inspire creativity through robot challenges and missions



DNA Finger Printing (Workshop)

DNA fingerprinting is a laboratory chemical method used to identify an individual from a sample of DNA by looking at unique patterns in their DNA. DNA fingerprinting can be applied to a variety of situations including criminal investigations and for forensic purposes, establish paternity and parentage, study biodiversity of species, track genetically-modified crops, and even to identify genetic conditions for disease prevention and cure. This workshop will provide hands-on experience on DNA profiling methods, analysis of forensic samples, data interpretation and case reporting.

Students will develop practical lab skills and knowledge by working in the laboratory as well as have an appreciation for DNA restriction enzyme functions and its applications in genetic engineering. Students will also have the opportunity to:

- Use electrophoresis to separate DNA fragments
- Use standard curves constructed from their data to make precise determinations of DNA fragment sizes
- Read plasmid maps and predict the sizes of DNA fragments from restriction enzyme digests prior to performing the laboratory activity
- Use restriction digest maps of lambda bacteriophage genomes to design novel plasmids
- Discuss scientific, ethical, and legal implications of forensics, DNA profiling, and genetic engineering



Media (Workshop)

The mass communications programmes offered are industry-focused and relevant to today's fast-paced media landscape. With MDIS' fully-equipped Radio and TV studios, as well as Audio and Video editing suites, students will have the opportunity to practise what they learn within their academic curriculum.



Healthcare and Nursing (Workshop)

The School of Health and Nursing (SHN) is a testament to MDIS's mission to provide globally recognised and competency-based programmes within the healthcare domain. The school trains nurses and healthcare professionals, enabling them to contribute meaningfully to the healthcare sector further.



Bacterial Staining Technique (Workshop)

Bacterial cells are challenging to view under the microscope due to their need for colour and contrast. Researchers have been using several types of stains to make these cells visible. These staining procedures help study the morphology, dimensions, cell size and arrangement of bacteria, thereby enabling successful identification. The Gram staining method is one of the most commonly used procedures that help differentiate between gram-positive and gram-negative bacteria.

The training and supervision provided in the School ensures that the students learn the skills and adapt to the laboratory environment quickly. They are trained to work with the laminar airflow cabinet to prevent contamination during practical work. Students learn about agar media, aseptic techniques and microscopy. The microscopic studies include observing the stained bacterial cells under the lowest magnification objective lens initially and gradually progressing to the oil immersion technique, which helps increase the microscope's resolving power. The students find these sessions to be fascinating, as it improves their scientific knowledge and practical skills.
